

# Connections to services include:

- **Housing** – Assistance in filling out TA applications, information to present as homeless at local counties, Referrals/screenings for emergency housing, shelters, supportive housing programs, residential housing programs, Coordinated entry, HUD programs, etc.
- **Medical** – Referrals for primary care doctor, care management services including Medicaid transportation, referrals for HIV/HEP C testing, etc.
- **Chemical Dependency Treatment** – Referrals and make connections for Intensive/non-intensive outpatient substance use treatment, residential programs, inpatient substance use treatment, detoxification, ABLE program, etc.
- **Mental Health Treatment** – Referrals and connections for mental health counseling, medication management, care management (Long term/short-term), etc.
- **PEER Support services** – Referrals for peer support, including dual diagnosis and criminal justice.
- **Care Management** – Referrals for long-term care management and short-term care management, will include linkage to Adult SPOA referrals, assistance with paperwork and recertifications for services through the local department of social services, assistance with medication management, assistance with transportation needs, assistance with obtaining basic needs; clothing, food, shelter.
- **LOSS (Local outreach to suicide survivors)** – Assisting in making connections with the LOSS team to reduce suicide bereavement distress, and provide compassion, support and resources for individuals.
- **Employment assistance** – Referrals to programs that assist with resume building, interview skills, job searching etc.
- **Veterans services** – Referrals to Adirondack Vets house, VA Case Management, etc.
